

Terms of Reference (TOR) for Stall Designer/Fabricator/Constructor of Nepal Stall at IFTM Top Resa 2018, Paris. France

Nepal Tourism Board is the National Tourism Organization (NTO) of Nepal established to develop, introduce and promote Nepal as an attractive tourist destination. All tourism marketing and promotional activities are carried out on three major segments: Nature, Culture and Adventure

For the fulfillment of the same objective, Nepal Tourism Board is participating in **IFTM Top Resa Paris 2018** for the destination promotion along with 06 Travel trade companies of Nepal. Hence Nepal Tourism Board requires the professional services of stall designer cum fabricators for design, build up and dismantling of Nepal Stall at IFTM Top Resa Paris, France, as per following details:

1. Fair Details:

Fair Date: 25-28 September, 2018

Fair Venue: PARIS, PORTE DE VERSAILLES, PAVILLON 7.2

Stall specifications as follows:

1. **Stall Number:** T 003
2. **Stall space:** 42 Sqm (4 Corners)
3. **Total number of co-exhibitors:** 06 with NTB as Main Exhibitor

2. **Scope of Work:** Design, build up and manage Nepal Stall at **IFTM Top Resa 2018** and dismantle the stall after completion of the fair.

3. Specific requirements for Nepal Stall

1. Design and erect a Nepal stall using Nepal's iconic tourism products/destinations either with modern paneling or the heritage/culture style and showcase the beautifully designed graphics of Nepalese tourism attractions on the wall panels (graphics to be finalized upon submission of the stall design)
2. Place a **3D Selfie booth** (graphics to be finalized upon submission of the stall design)
3. Provide all necessary logistic arrangements required for the stall including:
 - a. Flooring with carpet in the stall.
 - b. Main reception counter with branding for NTB with two chairs facing aisle in the prime location of the stand.
 - c. Nepal Brand and Signage should be prominent and visible to the visitors and the exhibitors.
 - d. 6 counters (lockable) for co-exhibitors with 2 chairs each with sufficient space in between
 - e. 6 Counter Branding with the Name and Logo of the Individual Company (Co-exhibitors).
 - e. 2 sets of round table with 4 chairs each for meeting purpose for co-exhibitors.
 - f. Placement of the co-exhibitors' counter towards aisle side directly facing walk ways in the halls.
 - g. Electrical supply and sufficient lighting for the stall, with plug points/sockets for each counter.
 - h. Storage room with lockable door in the stall with shelves and hangers.
 - i. Audio/visual display with LED screen/wall.
 - j. Wi-Fi/internet facility within stall accessible to all the co-exhibitors.
 - k. One bigger dustbin for store and 4 small ones in between counters.
 - l. Banner/standee to be placed in any visible area, displaying all co-exhibitors names.
 - m. 2-4 plants at the possible places/corners in the stall.
 - n. Hot & Cold Water dispenser with necessary supplies for all four days of the fair.
 - o. Any other effective creative elements for the value addition in Nepal's participation.
 - p. Dismantle the stall after the completion of the fair.
 - q. All required technical approvals for stand build up has to be managed by selected company itself.

3.1 NTB shall not make any payment for the dummy design which is not awarded the job

3.2 The selected company shall deal with the organizer in getting all technical approvals/permission/electricity supply/internet/ water connection, etc.

3.3 Nepal Tourism Board shall not make any payment for the design or submission of quotation/proposal, which is not selected for the job.

3.4 NTB shall make payment to the party whose design and quotation/proposal is approved and selected for the job. The modality of payment shall be as per terms and conditions agreed upon by both NTB and the party selected for this job.

- 3.5 The selected fabricator should quote the price including all applicable taxes and present the invoice for payment. However, if a company based/registered in India applies, such company has to submit/bid the proposal/quotations in Indian Currency. If such Indian company wins the bid and is awarded the job, in such condition, the company shall be paid in Indian currency (15 Percent Tax (TDS) shall be deducted from the total payment as per the Tax Law of Government of Nepal)
- 3.6 All the technical approval for the stall design should be taken by the selected Stall designer Company from the organizer.
- 3.7 Nepal Tourism Board shall have sole right to select or reject any/all design or quotation/proposal in its partial or complete form.
- 3.8 50% of the total amount quoted by the selected stall designer/fabricator will be paid in advance and the remaining 50% will be paid after the successful completion of the event.

In addition to the above main quotation please note following additional items may be required/ordered depending on the extra costs submitted:

- 1. Wifi/internet facility within stall
- 2. Extra electricity if needed

Should you be interested to execute Nepal stall design and fabrication job, as per above requirements please, submit a dummy design of the stall for the above mentioned tourism fair along with detailed cost break down and send us by 15th August 2018.
